
The junior children have learnt a new word this week...the word is *"unkempt"*

Spirit of the Herd Pony Sanctuary

I had the pleasure of meeting with Alex Irving from the Spirit of the Herd Pony Sanctuary at The Ridgeway in Frodsham last week. She talked at length about the passion they have for horses and ponies and about the positive impact they can have on humans too! They have accessed funding so that our school will be able to access support from them for some of our children, but she has asked me to share some information with you in case you would like to consider these sessions for anyone in your family. The sanctuary is a not-for-profit organisation that complements the rehabilitation work of rescued horses by engaging in equine therapy, a therapeutic service facilitated for people of all ages from the local area.
