Parents Evenings...



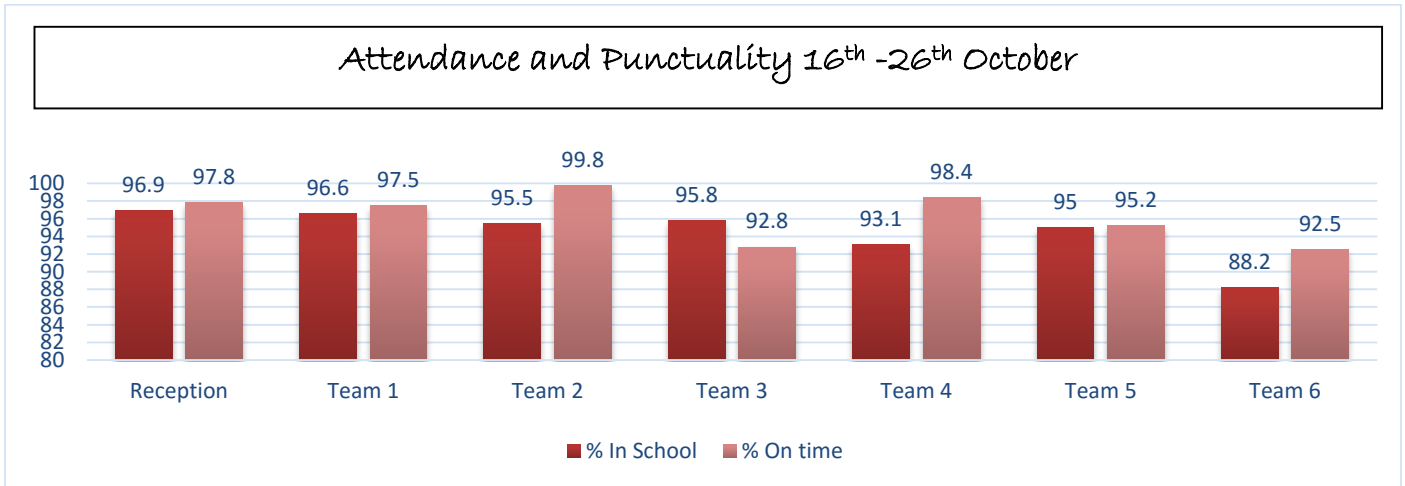
