



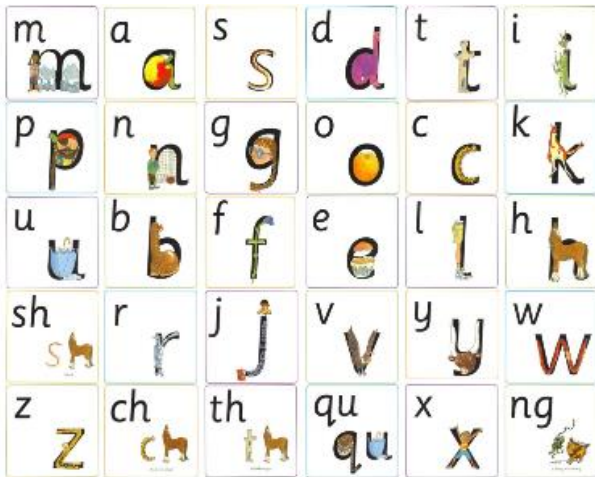

Handwriting at Horn's Mill

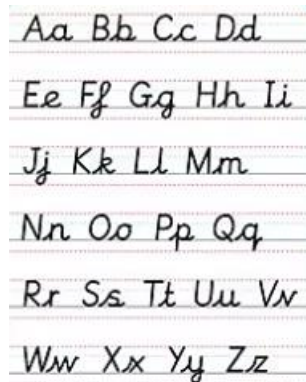
Handwriting is discretely taught across the school from Reception, once children are ready. Children will progress from learning correct pencil grip and letter formation to cursive and then joined.
